

**Tagout devices used for compliance with this standard must be:**

- ◆ **Provided by the employer. 1910.147(c)(5)(i)**
- ◆ **Singularly identified; shall be the only devices(s) used for controlling energy; shall not be used for other purposes. 1910.147(c)(5)(ii)**
- ◆ **Durable; shall be constructed and printed so that exposure to weather conditions or wet and damp locations will not cause the tag to deteriorate or shall be constructed of a material that will not be damaged by the conditions to which it will be subjected. 1910.147(c)(5)(iii)**



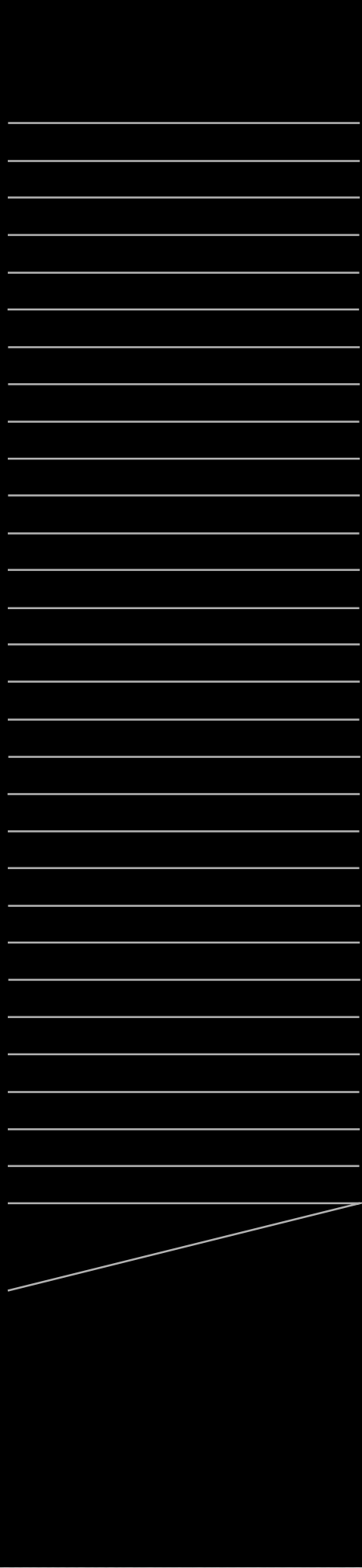




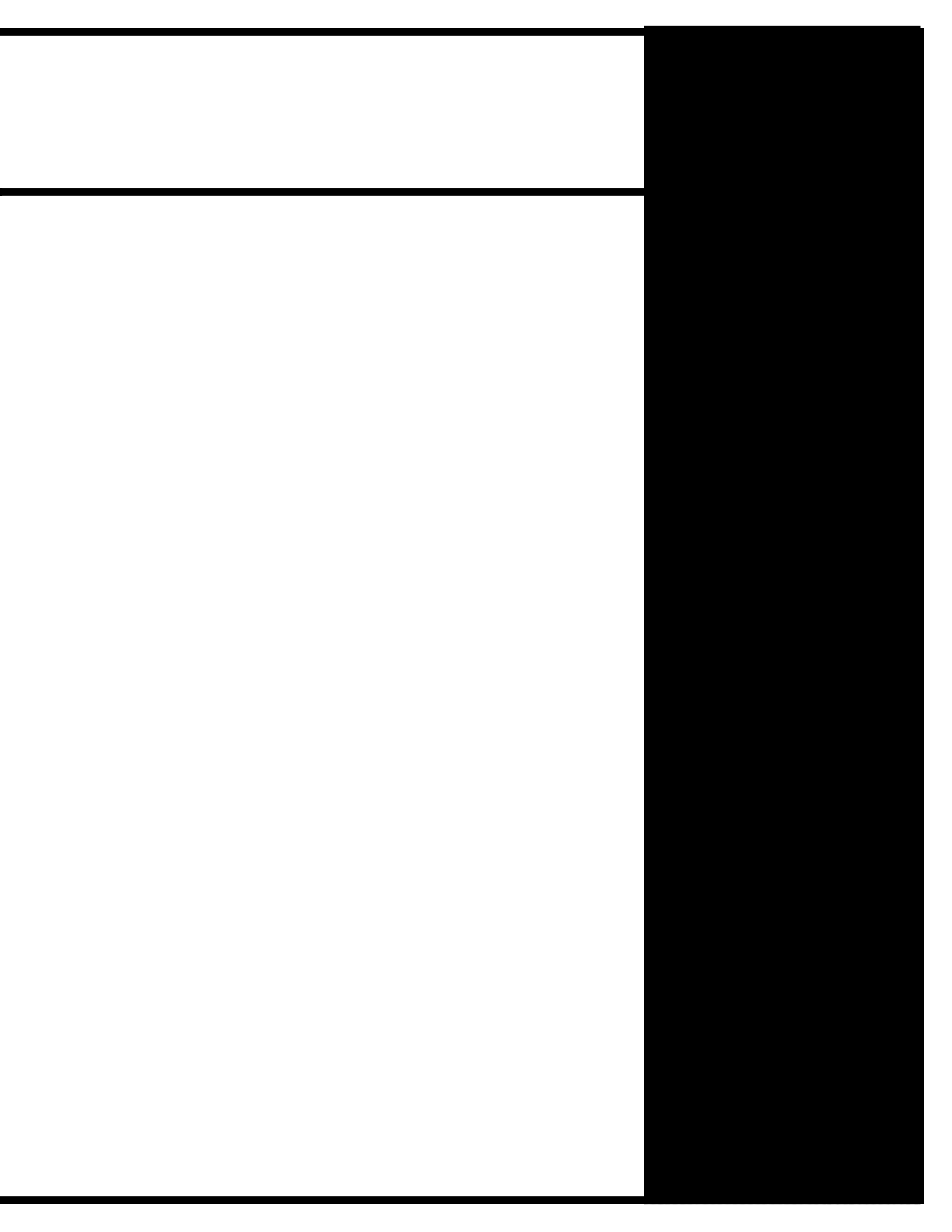

## 7. Release From Lockout or Tagout

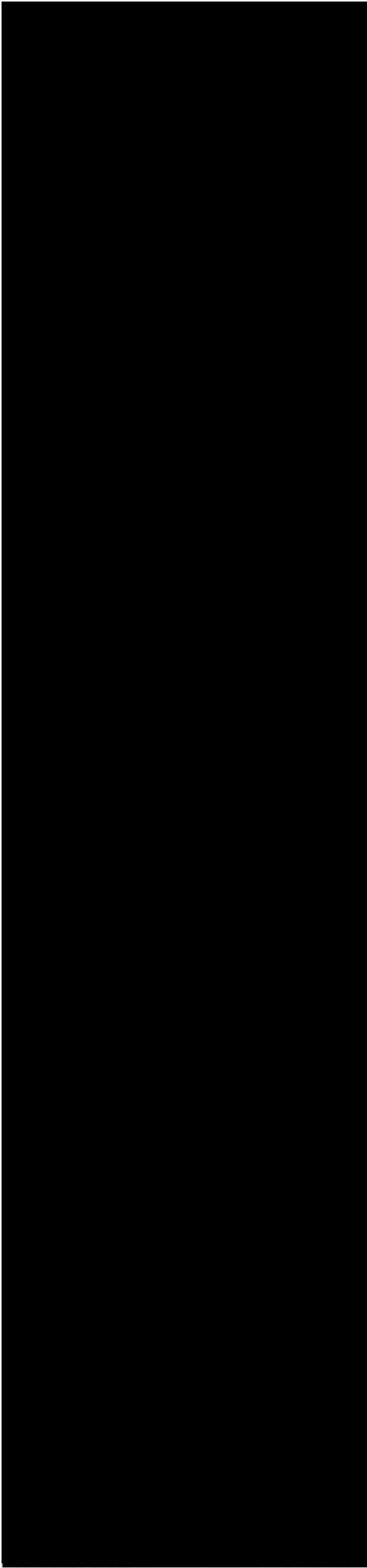
Once the work has been completed, it is important that your employees are just as careful in restarting the equipment as they were in shutting it down. Here are the rules:

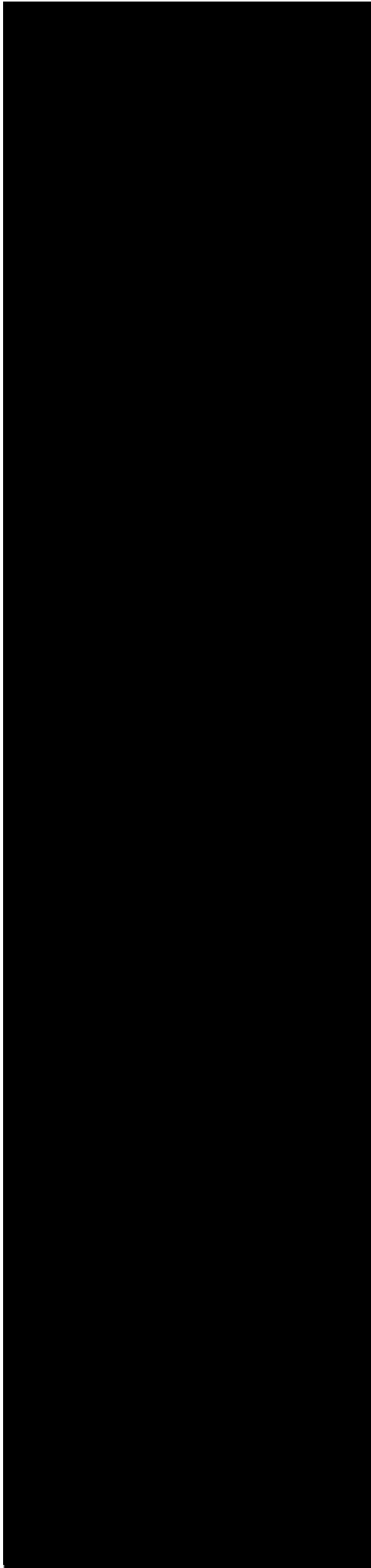
