Re-Notification Requirement for Small Quantity Generators

Required starting in 2021 as part of Nevada's updated hazardous waste regulations

On August 25, 2020, the State Legislative Commission approved the proposed <u>updates</u> to Nevada's hazardous waste regulations. One update that impacts all <u>Small Quantity Generators</u> (SQGs) of hazardous waste is the re-notification requirement. Beginning in 2021 and every 4 years thereafter, SQGs must re-notify the EPA by September 1 using <u>Form 8700-12</u>. This form, also called the RCRA Subtitle C Site Identification Form, is the same document used to obtain an EPA ID number. There is no fee for filing the re-notification form. While the form is fairly easy to complete, BEP is available for assistance if needed.

Small Business Economic Assistance Programs

City of Reno Small Business Economic Assistance Program

The <u>City of Reno Small Business Economic Assistance Program</u> is meant to assist businesses with 20 or fewer full-time employees (or equivalent) that are economically distressed as a result of COVID-19. Awards will be a maximum of \$20,000 and must be associated with costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The application period opened on Monday, August 31, 2020 and the deadline to apply is Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at 5 p.m. Contact the grant application hotline with questions at 775-334-2365 between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for more details.

County Small Business Grant Program

Douglas, Elko, Lincoln, Lyon, Nye, Storey, Washoe and White Pine Counties

The <u>County Small Business Grant Program</u> will be accepting applications from September 8, 2020 through October 6, 2020. The program, made possible due to CARES Act funding, is aimed at helping small businesses manage the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. To qualify, you must have a business license or applicable state business license. Grant award size varies by county, type of business and use of funds. <u>CLICK HERE</u> to preview the application.

Rental Assistance Grant Program for Nevada Small Businesses

Changes to the program including application deadline extended until September 8, 2020

The <u>Nevada Commercial Rental Assistance Grant (CRAG) Program</u>, opened on August 24th to provide commercial rental relief for Nevada small businesses including non-profits, sole proprietorships, independent contractors and self-employed persons. Several changes have been made since the program opened:

- Application deadline has been extended by a week to Tuesday, September 8, 2020 at 5 p.m.
- All entities who have received PPP or similar funding (in any amount) are now eligible to participate in CRAG; however funding will be awarded first to those entities who did not receive PPP or other forms of assistance in excess of \$5,000
- All eligible businesses who can verify a loss of at least 30% in revenue since the previous year are now eligible to receive the maximum grant award amount up to \$10,000
