An appeal of this Notice of Alleged Violation may be requested pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 445B.360 and State Environmental Commission (SEC) administrative rules. Appeals must be received within ten (10) days of receipt of this Notice of Alleged Violation by the facility's Responsible Official (RO) pursuant to NRS 445B.340. Appeals are processed through Sheryl Fontaine, the Executive Secretary for the SEC, at 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada, 89701-5249. NRS 445B.640 - Levy and disposition of administrative fines; additional remedies available; penalty for failure to pay administrative fine.

4. Any person who fails to pay a fine levied pursuant to subsection 1 or 2 within 30 days after the fine is imposed is guilty of a misdemeanor. The provisions of this subsection do not apply to persons found by the court to be indigent.
