BEP Wins Major US EPA Pollution Prevention Grant


BEP to provide support to auto body shops in Nevada

The newly announced grant from the US Environmental Protection Agency is part of a nationwide initiative to reduce pollution by limiting it at its sources. The Nevada Business Environmental Program is one of 48 agencies nationally that received a total of nearly \$19 million for pollution-prevention projects, and the \$350,000 grant to the Nevada program is among the largest.

A majority of the funds will support initiatives to reduce the pollution that results from auto body repairs. The grant also will support two national pollution-prevention conferences co-sponsored by BEP and the Pacific Northwest Pollution Prevention Resource Center. The first of the conferences is planned for the Seattle area in 2025; the second at Lake Tahoe in 2026.

US EPA Finalizes Amendments to Toxic Air Standards for Rubber Tire Manufacturing

On November 13, The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) finalized amendments to the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for rubber tire manufacturing. These updates address previously unregulated hazardous air pollutant (HAP) emissions from the rubber processing subcategory, ensuring compliance with Clean Air Act requirements for this industry. This action is expected to

reduce emissions of total hydrocarbons (THC) and filterable particulate matter (fPM) by about 171 tons annually. Read more about the final rule [here](#).
